

## 2025 CAREER BASED INTERVENTION-CAREER CONNECTIONS (CBI-CC) \$1000 Jeff Akers SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Any student (grades 7-9) enrolled in a Career Based Intervention-Career Connections Program is eligible to apply. (Applications limited to 2 per program.)

Upon confirmation of enrollment to an accredited postsecondary institution by the CBI-CC Board, a one time \$1,000 scholarship will be sent to the institution on behalf of the recipient. The recipient must successfully enroll in the first term of post secondary education within two years of earning a high school diploma. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
