- Awards:** Team plaques will be given to the top five places in each division. The first, second, and third place teams in each division will also receive individual medals. Certificates of participation will be provided to team coordinators for distribution to contestants.

- Deadlines:** So proper preparation may take place for the best possible competition, registration must be received no later than **March 28th**
- Contestants:** A team is defined as the students of one (1) class assigned on the Educational Management Information System (EMIS) report to a teacher/coordinator. The teacher of record must be the individual responsible for these students' work-based learning and related sections of the CBI program. Under no circumstances may any student participate on a team if he/she is not listed on that teacher/coordinator's EMIS report for that school year. A team will be disqualified if an ineligible student is placed on the team. This definition of 'team' applies to all types of programs (regardless of age) and all types of schools (including vocational schools and others with more than a single program).
- A team shall consist of any number of players between three (3) and ten (10) with no fewer than three (3) players and no more than ten (10) players. *There will be no substitutes!***
- Please make sure to read and follow the guidelines for the qualification of a middle school, junior, or senior division team as stated on the Knowledge Bowl program.

**Materials:** THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS **MUST BE PROVIDED BY EACH TEAM** FOR COMPETITION

- Adult Scorekeeper for every registered team competing (***MUST be an adult – no students***)
  1. Each coordinator must submit names of adult scorekeepers to Dustin Price by **March 28th** for proper competition placement.
  2. Scorekeepers are only permitted to score teams that have been assigned to them.
  3. Under no circumstances should a coordinator score his/her own team.
- Poster board or flip charts for team scoring **WITH EASELS**
- 8 X 11 **white** blank paper, 60+ sheets per team for answering questions by team captain
- 8 X 11 **colored** scratch paper
- Black markers for team captains to use for answering questions
- Black marker for scorekeeper
- Pens and/or Pencils
- Calculators

**Other Info:** Please prep your teams on acceptable conduct and attire. School rules apply while attending this event.

- Each team is required to provide an adult scorekeeper for **each registered team** competing. They may not score the team they came with. Scorekeepers could include the following: employers, advisory members, parents, administrators, bus drivers, etc.
- All coordinators not acting as an assigned scorekeeper must be seated in the gallery.
- Please provide adequate supervision for your students and your spectators. Parents and guests are welcome to attend and sit in the designated area.
- A location will be available for team photos. Please remember to bring your camera.
- **No electronic communication devices (including, but not limited to: cell phones / iPod, etc.) will be permitted at tables during the competition.**
- **Lunch** will **NOT** be provided, so please plan accordingly.

The CBI student activity committee is dedicated to providing a fun, fair, and rewarding event for all participants. Therefore, all rules will be strictly enforced.
