



\$1,000 THOMAS HYDE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Thomas Hyde Memorial Scholarship is in honor of one of Ohio's founding Occupational Work Experience (an earlier form of CBI) coordinators. Any student (grades 10-12) enrolled in a Career Based Intervention Program is eligible to apply. (Applications limited to 2 per program.)

Upon confirmation of enrollment to an accredited postsecondary institution by the CBI Board, a one time \$1,000 scholarship will be sent to the institution on behalf of the recipient. The recipient must successfully enroll in the first term of post secondary education within two years of earning a high school diploma. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
